THE CITY



Kaunas prides itself on its compact and well preserved Old Town, with its main streets traffic free. Beautiful 16th-century buildings adorn Vilnius Street, and many of these surround the Town Hall Square. You are likely to come across several modern art galleries housed in these historic buildings.

The city stands where the rivers Nemunas and Neris meet and you can easily lose count of the many green parks in its centre. Santaka Park, being just one of them, is a stunning place to stroll among birch, oak and maple trees. It's hard to believe you are still in the heart of such an energetic city.

Tree-lined Laisves Aleja, also known as Freedom (or Liberty) Avenue, is the main artery of the city, where you'll find many shops to browse around and cafés and bars from which to people-watch. In the centre of this avenue there is a large fountain, a general meeting place for locals and visitors alike.

Kaunas holds Lithuania's spirit and it's eager to share its essence with new and old friends. It's waiting to be rediscovered.

DO & SEE



Visit! The remarkable Old Town which is a collection of ancient architectural monuments: the remnants of the 14th century with remains of Kaunas castle, the buildings of the Middle Ages in the Gothic and the Art Déco styles. The Kaunas Fortress is a valuable military heritage composed of a number of constructions that used to be a military complex. There are nine Forts around the city and the IXth Fort serves a museum. The macabre collection of nearly 3,000 devils at the Devils' Museum and the exhibitions showing the unique artistic styles of composer and painter M. K. Ciurlionis, as well as J. Maciunas initiator of the avant-garde Fluxus art movement.

Town Hall and Town Hall Square – (Rotušės Aikštė)



Town Hall is distinguished by its slenderness and grace; it is often called The White Swan. Its tower of height of 53 meters is the

highest in the old city. Present Town Hall located

in the square was not the first in Kaunas. The previous one was destroyed by the fire. New Town Hall started to be built in the marketplace centre in 1542. Wax melting furnaces of the 15th century were discovered near the tower in 1973. Since 2002, one of the furnaces is exposed in the paving.

Town Hall houses Kaunas City Museum. It represents the history of Kaunas, shows political and cultural life and tells the visitors the most important and interesting facts about the city.

The ensemble of Pažaislis buildings and Camaldolli abbey



It ranks among the most beautiful Baroque-style buildings in Lithuania. Also called Baroque pearl, is one of the most wonderful masterpieces

of late Baroque architecture in North Eastern Europe. The church and abbey were built for Camaldolese (Benedictine) monks in the 17th century under the supervision of Italian masters from Florence (Michelangelo Palloni, Joan Merli, and Pietro Perti).

About 140 frescoes of various sizes survived in the buildings of the monastery ensemble. You can see a famous painting the Mother of Fair Love in the monastery, which was presented to Kristupas Zigmantas Pacas, the founder of Pažaislis Church, by Pope Alexander VII in 1661. There is a museum in Pažaislis Monastery and next to it, a unique Hospitality complex "Monte



Pacis" where one may taste historical dishes of nuns with modern interpretations. Distance from the city centre 10 km.

Interesting! The beauty of the Abbey was well known in Europe, thus the Abbey was visited by King of Sweden Karol XII and Tsars Alexander I and Nikolaj I. The latter was so delighted by the beauty of the church that he assigned 130 thousands roubles for its reconstruction to the Provoslav one.

Kaunas Castle



Supposedly, the first brick castle at the confluence of the rivers the Nemunas and the Neris was built at the 14th century when the

attacks of Teutonic Order began. The castle was fence-type, without towers, it had double walls from stones and bricks from the outside. This defensive castle framed a powerful barrier and the knights did not resolve to attack the castle for decades, thus they used to bypass Kaunas in war marches. However, the castle of Kaunas was strongly broken down by a flood of the river Neris. Both northern towers and more than a half of the castle walls were blown down after the water wash.

Aleksotas funicular



Aleksotas funicular This unique mean of transportation was built in 1935. Authentic traction equipment, which has functioned for

more than seventy years, is still in use today, including the genuine pre-war wagon, wooden seats, and stop platforms.

Even today the funicular takes people up the Aleksotas hill, from which the panorama of the Kaunas city centre and Old town is wide open. Kaunas is the only city among Baltic States, where such means of transportation is available.

Žaliakalnis funicular



It is the oldest funicular in Lithuania and was constructed by the engineering office Curt Rudolph Transportanlagen from

Dresden, Germany with electric equipment from "AEG" and mechanical parts from Bell Maschinenfabrik, Switzerland. The official opening was on 5th of August in 1931 with one passenger car, while the second car was only a platform ballasted with stones used to counterbalance the passenger car. Kaunas is the only city in Lithuania with this type of transport. In the residential district of Žaliakalnis these "climbing cars" serve both as a means of transport and entertainment. Žaliakalnis funicular provides an easy way of reaching the Resurrection Church from the city centre.

The Wooden Architecture of Kaunas



"Lithuania has something to show to the world. One of the wonders is wooden architecture." Gilles Vuillard The tradition of wood construction was

widespread in Lithuania. Many old rural homes



and wooden church have been studied. Trees were a popular building material in interwar Kaunas because masonry construction costs were too high for many home owners. Today the wooden architecture of the city is perceived as an aesthetic and ethical value. Wooden architecture experts see the value of the houses; they discover it on the educational tours of Žaliakalnis, Panemunė, Šančiai, and Vilijampolė as well. For heritage lovers, the intrinsic value of wooden houses is indisputable. Without these houses the city would lose a very important part of its cultural identity. Unfortunately, only a small portion of the inter-war wooden houses passed the test of time and resisted the social and economic temptations, but they keep alive the interwar Kaunas suburban spirit.

M. K. Čiurlionis National Museum of Art



Named after Lithuania's most prominent artist and composer, this gallery displays the largest collection of Lithuanian art. The museum

INTERESTING: Kaunas is the city related to creation of M.K. Čiurlionis, the Lithuanian genius artist, composer and painter of the worldwide importance. Oeuvre of M.K. Čiurlionis, one of the grand and characteristic representatives of the Art Nouveau, a progenitor of modern art in Lithuanian and the father of modernism, is housed in the art gallery named after him. In the

exposition of his paintings M.K. Čiurlionis is revealed as a lyric symbolist, esoteric and "magic" artist. The gallery also aims to introduce music of M.K. Čiurlionis to the visitors.

Architecture. Modernism



Modernism ideas which spread fast among most countries of the Western World after World War I soon emerged in Lithuania as well. In 1920

when Poland occupied Vilnius, Kaunas became the capital of the independent Republic of Lithuania (1920–1939) and the most important Lithuanian city. As the economy was growing, it was sought to make the capital a modern European city. Lithuanian architects started to design and build houses in the style of modernism, in German called the Bauhaus, which was avant-garde in Europe and the USA at that time. Up to the present day Kaunas is



probably the only city in the world where so many buildings of this style were built and have remained intact. Each of the architects who created here had their own individual style which was distinguished for different modern variations. These variations included historical elements, a search for national style or just attempts to convey the main modernism principles.

The European Commission officially confirmed that Kaunas, famous for its unique modernist architecture of the interwar period, is awarded the European Heritage Label.

Sugihara house



Sugihara house was a Japanese consulate in 1939-1940 where a famous Japanese diplomat Chiune Sugihara have been working. This

diplomat became famous when he saved the lives of about 10,000 Lithuanian, Polish and German Jews during the years of World War II. He issued "life visas" to Japan without any official approval of Japanese Government. Many Jews called the gates which once were next to the house the



"gates of hope". On 2 August 1940 all foreign consulates in Lithuania were closed; however, the Japanese consulate moved to the accommodation of the Kaunas restaurant Metropolis and continued to issue visas. Even before leaving Lithuania and sitting at the table on the railway platform Sugihara managed to issue several tens of visas. In 1999 the museum was founded by the efforts of Lithuanian and Belgian intellectuals and businessmen, seeking to commemorate the Japanese diplomat. The museum exhibits Chiune Sugihara's life moments and stories of his saved people and their relatives who live all over the world.



Museum of the Ninth (IX) Fort of Kaunas



In 1959, the museum was opened here, and in 1984, the memorial was completed. It consists of the administration building, a new museum,

the old fort with its wards and tunnels, and the monument to the 9th fort victims close to the field of death. The monument is 30 m tall. The museum contains collections of genocide and holocaust, executed during Soviet's and Hitler's occupation, also are accumulated and protected historic materials of Kaunas strong hold and 9th Fort.

Christ's Resurrection church



It started to be built in 1932 under the project of the architect K. Reisonas. The church is assumed to be the symbol of the Lithuanian independence.

It was built from the contributions of people. When Lithuania lost its independence, the construction was already ending, however, there was no interior and the outside was not daubed. In 1940, the church was confiscated, and machine shop of the Radio factory was founded in 1952. In 1989, the building was returned to religious community and after 70 years from the construction beginning the church was sanctified on December 24th in 2004. Visitors have the possibility to go to the observation deck on the church roof to enjoy the panoramic view of the city.

The Historical Presidential Palace



The building was constructed in 1860. In 1876, the czarist government bought it and established the residence of the governor. When

Lithuanian Independence was restored and



Kaunas became the provisional capital of Lithuania, this building from 1919 to 1940 was the Presidential Palace of the Republic of Lithuania. Presidents of Lithuania A. Smetona, K. Grinius and A. Stulginskis used to live and work in this palace.

Today the Historical Presidential Palace of the Republic of Lithuania in Kaunas functions as a memorial-educational institution of Lithuanian modern statehood. The permanent exposition at the Palace reflects the history of the First Republic of Lithuania (1918 – 1940). Periodic temporary exhibitions commemorate outstanding historical figures and events.

Perkūnas (Thunder) House



Perkūnas (Thunder)
House is considered to be one of few buildings belonging to the gothic period that stands till now. It is assumed to be a

merchant's residential house built in beginning of the 16th century. It is one of the most original examples of the flamboyant Gothic architecture in Lithuania. In 1818, when the reconstruction works were performed, a statue was found in one of the walls of the house, which supposedly belonged to the Pagan God Perkūnas. Due to this statue this house was given a name of Perkūnas (Thunder).



Laisvės (Freedom) Avenue



It is the avenue of length of 1621 meters: two lines of trees planted in the middle of the avenue created the recreation and walking area. Already

from the end of the 19th century, it became an administrational, commercial and cultural centre of the city. After the reconstruction from 1982, Laisvės Avenue became a pedestrian street. It is favourite place of the walk and meetings of Kaunas citizens.

The Era of Diplomacy in Kaunas



Historical circumstances led to the 1919-1940 period being named the era of diplomacy in Kaunas. Thanks to historical circumstances,

Kaunas became the temporary capital of the reborn State of Lithuania (1918). Lithuania took the first steps to nationhood there: the country's most important institutions and foreign diplomatic missions were founded.

Kaunas was never officially ratified in writing as the temporary capital. In diplomatic terms, Kaunas became the de facto capital of Lithuania when the provisional government moved there from Vilnius on 2 January 1919. That same year,



the central street of the town was renamed Laisvės Alėja (Liberty Avenue), and a street abutting it in honor of February 16th. And the streets still have those names today. The first president in the history of Lithuania was elected in Kaunas. On 4 April 1919, in Kaunas, the Council of Lithuania elected Antanas Smetona. The Constituent Assembly of Lithuania gathered in the capital, Kaunas, for its first meeting on 15 May 1920, in the the State Theatre, the current Musical Theater.

The country's most important institutions operated in Kaunas, among them the Lithuanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, which had a critical challenge to establish diplomatic relations with foreign countries and represent Lithuania in the international arena. Diplomatic missions gradually began to settle here. First of all the diplomatic missions of the great powers visited Kaunas – the US, Britain, and France – and later permanent embassies and consulates of these and other countries settled in. These government agencies and foreign representative offices operated in Kaunas in 1939:

St. Peter & Paul's Cathedral



St. Peter & Paul's is the largest Gothic structure in Lithuania as well as the country's only Gothic church with a basilica floor-plan as opposed to

the usual cross-shaped design. The breath-taking interior, which stands among one of the most beautiful of its kind in the country, boasts nine separate altars with the high-Baroque main altar being the central focus. The light Renaissance and Baroque touches are the result of renovations from the middle of the 17th century.

St. George Church and Bernardines' Monastery



It is considered to be one of the first churches in Kaunas. A wooden church near the castle was built for Bernardines monks who settled in the city in

1468. A brick St. George church began to be built in 1471. It is unknown precisely when it was finished, but it was already functioning from 1503. High span roof, large volume and unplastered brick walls accentuate the Gothic nature of the building. The church contains three naves and five spans. The walls of width of 1.4 meter are buttressed by massive abutments. This church suffered from the fires, wars, and was reconstructed more than once. In 1812, Napoleon's army turned the church to the flour storehouse. For the last time big repair of the church was performed in 1936. There was the storehouse during the post-war. The monks recovered the church, which was indeed in a sad state, in 2005. A brick building lying next to the church was built in the 16th century, which maintained many elements typical to the pointed style.

Lithuanian Bank



International contest of the project of Lithuanian bank was declared, and the first place was taken by the team of the architects from Paris.

However, the designed building was too expensive, therefore a new project was assigned to be prepared by M. Songaila, the professor of Lithuanian architecture and the chairman of the jury committee. The construction was finished in 1928. The Bank is the building on the corner, having different façades, which is monumental, and distinguishes for its magnificence. A sculptural group with national and Lithuania's statehood symbols is pictured in front of a half-round window in the triangle gable on the main façade. Fortunately, it was protected from destruction during the Soviet period by concreting over the Lithuanian symbols - pillars

of Vytis and Gediminas. Antique themes predominate in the Operation hall. It is one of the safest banks. The valuables are secure in the pre-war English safe-deposits. Interior of 1929 was restored in 1996-1997. It is one of the most valuable inter-war buildings of social purpose. The Museum was opened in the bank, which presents exhibits related to the development of banking and monetary relations in Lithuania, videotapes on the Bank of Lithuania, production of currency and its security features.

Vytautas the Great Bridge (Vytauto Didžiojo tiltas)



The original bridge on wooden poles was built in 1812. It was used by Napoleon's Army fleeing from Russia.

Poland, where the Napoleonic Code and even different calendars were used. Jokingly, Aleksotas Bridge was called the longest bridge in the world: the Slavic (Julian) calendar was used in the province of Kaunas, whereas Užnemunė used the Catholic (Gregorian) calendar; therefore, it took 13 days to cross the bridge (the old calendar was 13 days behind the new one). The bridge had a draw mechanism, which did not function properly and, therefore, was never used.

Sculptures of bugs (Perpetuation of the Menory of Ladislas Starewich)



Ladislas Starewich (1882–1965) (Władysław Starewicz in Polish, Vladislavas Starevičius in Lithuanian), the master of cinema alchemy, Polish

speaking Lithuanian director, the pioneer of doll animation, began creating in the first half of the 20th century in Lithuania, Russia and France. The artist was the first to use dolls in his movies, and produced his creation in such a level which was not achieved by his contemporaries. Moreover, titled as a European Walt Disney, Ladislas Starewich created a new technique of animation. However, the world famous Lithuanian used to be and still is better known in Moscow and Paris than in Lithuania. The first animated short, entitled The Battle of the Stag Beetles in 1910, which became the starting milestone of his unique art, was created in Kaunas while working in Kaunas Museum (in the building of the present Museum of the History of Communications). Sadly, many citizens of Kaunas have not noticed the playful memorial dedicated to Ladislas Starewich in the Town Hall Square - a video plaque (author - Jurgita Gerdvilaitė) with a small screen in the middle showing animated shorts of Starewich all day and night. Back in 2008, in Lithuania, the full length documentary The Bug Trainer was created in dedication to Ladislas Starewich highlighting the most important and interesting aspects of his life and productions. Three sculptures of bugs representing the three main characters in his animated shorts - a stag-beetle, an ant and a grasshopper were set out next to the memorial plaque in Rotušės a. (Town Hall sq.) 18. The idea how to perpetuate the memory of Ladislas Starewich was offered by



the sculptor Algimantas Šlapikas, the sculptures were carried out by the blacksmith Zenonas Baranauskas. The bug trio established their presence in the neighbourhood of Town Hall Square.

and over 88 000 mobile exhibits). The museum presents the mode of life, works, and traditions of peasants and townspeople of all Lithuanian ethnographic areas: Dzūkija, Aukštaitija, Suvalkija, Žemaitija and Lithuania Minor. There are fragments of the villages, authentic farms, century-old buildings with flower gardens, orchards and vegetable gardens, with crosses and wooden roofed poles, technical facilities – mills, forges, a fulling-mill and oil-mill lining along 7 km circular route, meandering between forests, meadows and hills.

Taste it!

Black bread is the pride of Lithuanian cuisine. It was highly valued and even called "sacred"; from old times Lithuanians related it with magic and superstitious beliefs.

Beer is valued for its special taste not only in Lithuania but also abroad. There are two breweries "Kauno alus" (Kaunas Beer) and "Volfas Engelman" in Kaunas and we recommend you taste their products.

Cold beetroot soup is traditional pink cold soup made of beetroots and served with boiled potatoes. This dish is especially popular in summer.

Potato dumplings (Lith. cepelinai) is dish made of grated and/or mashed boiled potatoes with meat, curds or other fillings, also called "big dumplings"; it is an inseparable part of traditional cuisine.

Baroque tree cake known as Šakotis. This high branchy hollow baked product which resembles a fir is one of the most popular confectionery products in Lithuanian cuisine; Lithuanian monasteries started to bake Šakotis in 20th century. It's a great dessert!

Stumbras production. Stumbras is the biggest and most popular producer of spirits in Lithuania. You may buy Stumbras production both in the shop of Stumbras Museum and specialized shops. (Consuming alcohol, you risk your health, welfare of your family and society.) "Volfas Engelman" production. "Volfas Engelman" is one of the most modern breweries in Lithuania, producing beer, cider and kvass



which you may buy in the shopping centres.

Production of brewery "Kauno alus" (Kaunas Beer). It is the only larger company which performs open fermentation of beer. The brewery "Kauno alus" constantly ferments 13 kinds of beer which you may buy in the biggest shopping centres of Kaunas.

Black bread is Lithuanians' special pride which was the main meal in Lithuanian villages up to the 20th century. The types of traditional Lithuanian bread are the following: rye bread, wheat bread and triticale bread.

Amber is called "Lithuanian gold". Amber is used to create unique jewellery and unusual art works; it is distinguished for its stimulating and strengthening properties. Therefore, from old times it has been used not only for decoration but also for treatment. Lithuanians' ancestors protected themselves from the dark powers by wearing amber amulets. Amber therapy is becoming more and more popular: amber spirits and preparations with amber acid, oil or powder are made, healing and strengthening amber tea is drunk.

Flax, also called "North silk". Through the centuries Lithuanians have cherished traditions of flax growing and processing which are valued not only in Lithuania. We suggest that you buy flax textile products of high quality in specialized shops.


