### Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport



Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) is located nine miles (14.5 km) south of the city. The airport serves over 100

million passengers every year.

MARTA (Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority) operates light rail services from the airport to Downtown and throughout the metropolitan area. A single ticket to Downtown Atlanta is \$1.75, and the Peachtree center station is in the heart of the Downtown hotel district. Taxi services take 15-60 minutes to Five Points, depending upon traffic - fares vary from \$20 - \$26, according to the number of passengers and amount of luggage. Taxis usually have flat rates to the central business district.

The Atlanta Link provides airport shuttle service from Downtown, Midtown and Buckhead hotels. Reservations for shared-ride shuttles to Atlanta, Atlanta metro and non-metro areas can be secured at the Ground Transportation Center's island F.

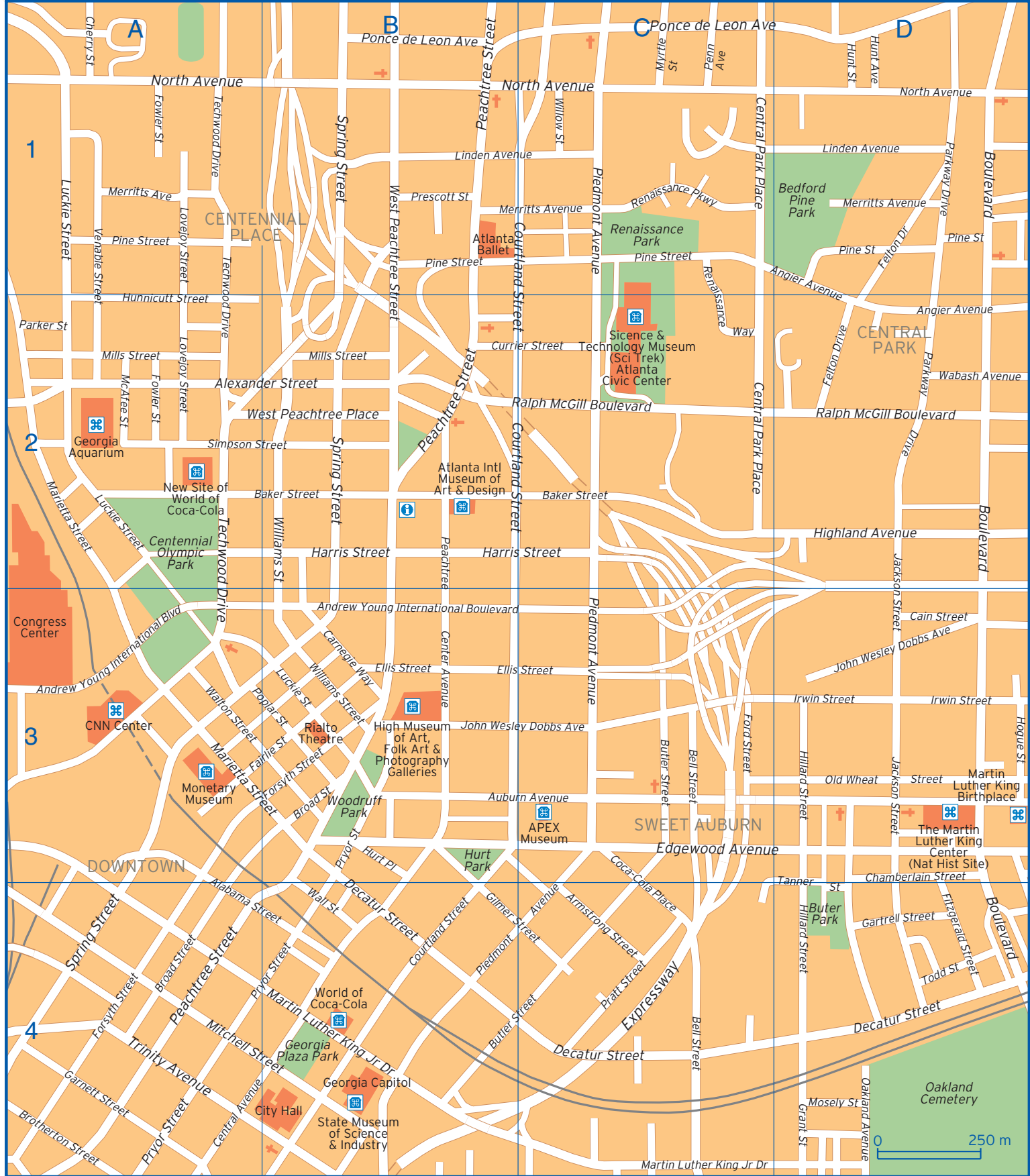
