A monument was erected in front of the ramparts of the Fortress in memory of the thousands of soldiers who perished in the battle.

The fortification work which the Swedes had begun was subsequently continued by the Russians. The oldest surviving building in the Fortress date from the Russian period in the 1770s. Among those directing the fortification works was Count Aleksander Suvorov who had been assigned to the task and sent to south-east Finland by the Empress of Russia, Catherine the Great. The Fortress thus became an important link in the three-stage-fortification system designed to protect St. Petersburg.

Today the Fortress area is an interesting attraction for tourists as well as local people: you can have a delicious meal in Linnoituksen Krouvi restaurant (open during summer time), enjoy your dessert at the lovely old fashioned café Majurska, visit the handicraft shops and buy some local souvenirs to take home!

Säräpirtti has standard serving times for which advance booking is required, since the dish takes up to nine hours to prepare. For groups of more than ten, a specific time can also be booked.

The new City Brook in Imatra

Imatran Valtionhotelli

Imatra Valtionhotelli is an art nouveau style hotel, standing near by the Imatrankoski rapids, and it was built in 1903. Before in its place were two hotels, which were unfortunately perished in a fire. After the disaster, the decision was made to build the strikingly beautiful castle its now known for.

The hotel was built by the command of Finland's senate and it was planned to satisfy the needs of the tourists from St. Petersburg. The hotel was designed by architect Usko Nyström in an art nouveau style, containing lots of elements from nature, as well as a unusual resemblance of a medieval castle.

During the first years after the hotel was opened, it was frequently visited by the aristocracy of St. Petersburg and the members of the Finnish government. Among the most notorious visitors were Nicolai II and his family.

The hotel has also served as a military hospital during the civil war of 1917. And, during the

Second World War it served as a staff headquarters of the Finnish army and, later on, it functioned as headquarters of military administration. An interesting little fact during those years was that the tallest tower was flattened for the Second World War, used for spotting enemy planes coming from the East.

The distinct hotel is one of the must-see places in Imatra and it is also considered to be one of the most beautiful pieces of architecture Finland.

The hotel is also well known for its unparalleled customer service, and modern, yet unique rooms.

The hotel also includes a Spa-hotel wing with pampering treatments and conference facilities with cutting-edge technology, serving the needs of meetings and conferences of all kind. To top it all off, the hotel's own Linnasali restaurant is considered to be one of the best restaurants in the region and is a popular place for weddings and other celebrations.

Café Röytty

The house Röytty was first time mentioned at the end of the 17th century as a military residence.



From 1700 to 1937 Röytty served as a guest house. At the beginning of the 20th century, half of the real estate was taken over by the family Rikkonen.

Veikko Rikkonen (1934-2015), the last Head of the estate, sold the house to the Municipality of Taipalsaari in 1988. Local Heritage House Röytty was opened in 1996. Since 2013, local associations have been running a café here in the summer and at Christmas. Taipalsaari Artisans have their sales exhibition in the side rooms of the house, and horse-drawn vehicles are presented in the stable museum.

Hiitolanjoki river

Hiitolanjoki is a 53 kilometres long river. 8 kilometres of the river streams in Rautjärvi in South Karelia and 45 kilometres in Hiitola in Russia. Water of the river comes from Simpelejärvi (Simpele Lake) and water flows to Laatokka Lake in Russia. There are 12 rapids in the river. Formerly Hiitolanjoki has been a waterway, a source of fishes, a transport channel and lastly a source of power for hydroelectric plant. All four rapids on Finland's side of the border, Juvankoski, Ritakoski, Lahnanen and Kangaskoski, are dammed up to produce electricity. The river area is interesting attraction to visit, whether you are fisher, hiker or for example interested in cultural history.

Lappee church

Lappee church is a wooden so called double cruciform church situated in the centre of the city. The church is built in the year 1794. Juhana Salonen, a church builder from Savitaipale, has built the current church. During the years the building has gone through many fixing and modification works. Aleksandra Frosterus-Såltin has painted the altarpiece, which represents the Ascension of the Christ, in 1887. The other paintings are made by artists, who have remaind unknown. The existing organ are from the year 1967. The church serves travellers as a road church.

Northern lights

The northern lights dancing up above is such a powerful and unique natural phenomenon. Finland is one of the best places to spot the lights. In northern Lapland the lights shine about every other clear night between September and March. But it is possible to see that shine also in Lappeenranta and Imatra region. In southern Finland they are visible on about 10-20 nights a year.

Northern lights are caused by electronically charged particles originating from the sun. Multi-coloured displays form when different atmospheric gases are agitated by this solar wind.

How to catch northern lights?

Look to the stars. If the night sky is clear and starry, your chances to see the northern lights are good.

Stay outside. The lights might unexpectedly appear and just as suddenly vanish any time from just after sunset to the moment before dawn.

Wrap up warm. It tends to be very chilly on the clear winter nights when the lights are most easily seen.

Ruokolahti Church Hill

Ruokolahti church hill is located in beautiful place precisely on a shore of Saimaa lake. The current church on Ruokolahti church hill is forth church of Ruokolahti. The wooden church completed in the year 1854. The most well-known building in the church hill is a belltower, completed in 1752. Saimaa Canal

The first plans to construct a waterway between Lake Saimaa and the Gulf of Finland were put forward as early as 1499 but it was not until at the beginning of the 19th century that plans to build the canal were revived. The building of the Canal began in 1845 and it was opened for traffic on 7 September 1856. The building of the present Canal was begun in 1963, and it was inaugurated in 1968 by the then President of Finland, Dr. Urho Kekkonen.

The total length of the Canal is 43 km, of which 23 km lies on the Finnish side of the border and the remaining 20 km in the section leased from Russia. The difference between the water levels of Lake Saimaa and the Gulf of Finland totals 76 metres, and is offset by means of eight locks. Goods are transported along the Saimaa Canal to various areas in Finland as well as to several countries in Europe.

One way of exploring the Saimaa Canal is to take a boat trip from Lappeenranta to the Mälkiä lock and back. In summer, there is also a daily boat service from Lappeenranta to Vyborg in Russia. The Canal on the Finnish side is open to all free of charge. You can also enjoy a boat trip along



the whole length of the Canal, all the way to Vyborg and onward to the Gulf of Finland. Additional information about canal travel is available from the Canal authorities.

The Canal Museum's pleasant café is also well worth a visit. Large-scale renovations are underway in the area, to improve the tourism services. We welcome you to visit the Saimaa Canal and study its glorious 150-year history in the Saimaa Canal Museum exhibition, and to take a two-hour cruise on the canal or a cruise to Vyborg.

Salpalinja fortifications

Salpalinja constructions from the years 1941-44 in eastern parts of Luumäki. Salpalinja forms Finland's largest line of defence. The building of the fortifications was begun in 1940-41 by order of Marshall Mannerheim, then the Supreme Commander of the Finnish Army. The Salpalinja is made of over 1200 kilometres of reinforced concrete, wood, barbed wire and stone. The

reconstructed bunkers in Luumäki, Lemi, Roukolahti and Ylämaa are worth to visit.

The purpose of the fortification system was to protect Finland's eastern frontier.

During the construction period, the fortification system represented the largest building site in Finland: over 35000 men worked there, with 2000 women supplying the builders with provisions. Salpalinja stretched all the way to the northern frontier of Finland, and full advantage was taken of the contours of the terrain in the course of its construction. The fortified section which remains in Luumäki features a variety of tank traps, and dugouts used by the soldiers of the Finnish Army.

Salpa-asema is situated in Luumäki, right next to Highway 6. At this fascinating site, the visitor has the opportunity to explore the comprehensive fortification system dating from the days of the Continuation War (1941-44). The Salpalinja Fortifications are open in summer, and by prior arrangement.


